ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CITY OF JACKSON, STARK LANE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (WDID#5B03CR00104), AMADOR COUNTY

This Order responds to the 22 April 2026 request for an amendment of the Stark Lane Bridge Replacement Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B03CR00104). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 21 April 2026. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

The City of Jackson is requesting a correction to the Project schedule identified on page 2 of the Certification. The original Certification states the Project schedule as "1 July 2026 through 31 October 2026." The City of Jackson requests a longer timeframe to complete work to account for potential delays in construction.

The Certification has been amended to reflect the updated Project schedule as: "1 July 2026 through 31 October 2027."

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$4,212.00 for the original Certification were received on 26 February 2026. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3383(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), as was calculated as category E - Low Impact Discharges (fee code 87) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
