NOTICE OF TERMINATION; GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2022-0006-03 FOR LIMITED THREAT DISCHARGES TO SURFACE WATER, UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, DUNSMUIR RAILYARD DEWATERING PROJECT, SISKIYOU COUNTY

Thank you for submitting the Notice of Termination Form dated 17 November 2025 requesting termination of coverage under Limited Threat General Order R5-2022-0006-03 for the Dunsmuir Railyard Dewatering Project (Project).

On 3 April 2023, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability (NOA) for the Project, which was assigned Limited Threat General Order R5-2022-0006-011 and Waste Discharger Identification 5A471001002, and the original NOA was amended on 29 March 2024. Except for purposes of enforcement, coverage is hereby terminated as of **17 February 2026** through this letter.

Please note that you must still submit your last quarterly monitoring report required under the Limited Threat General Order. Failure to do so subjects you to mandatory minimum penalties or discretionary penalties.
