TENTATIVE REVISED DRAFT, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR LOUISIANA-PACIFIC RED BLUFF CLASS III WOOD WASTE LANDFILL, RED BLUFF, TEHAMA COUNTY

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and a Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Red Bluff Class III Wood Waste Landfill (LP Red Bluff Landfill). To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 9 September 2024**. Written materials submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 9 September 2024** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its 17/18 October 2024 Board Meeting located in Clearlake, CA 95422, beginning at 8:30am. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. By **14 August 2024**, post one (1) copy of the Notice at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **21 August 2024**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the Discharger only.
