CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD CENTRAL VALLEY REGION ORDER R5-2026-XXXX RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board), finds that the Board adopted the following Order which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

CIRCLE OAKS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT (CWD), CIRCLE OAKS WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY (WWTF), NAPA COUNTY, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 94-097

Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order 94-097 adopted by the Central Valley Water Board on 22 April 1994, prescribes requirements for the Circle Oaks WWTF (Facility) in Napa County. On 8 July 2021, the Circle Oaks County Water District (CWD) submitted a Report of Waste Discharge to obtain coverage under the Statewide General Order 2014-0153-DWQ for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems. Regulation of the discharge was transferred to enrollment under General Order WQ 2014-0153-DWQ-R5432, which was issued by the Executive Officer on 25 November 2025. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order 94-097.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Orders are to be rescinded.
