NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will consider adoption of the subject Order at a public meeting scheduled for:

The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed order.

Opportunities to Comment

The Central Valley Water Board will consider oral and written comments on the proposed Order before it votes on whether to adopt the Order.

Written comments or evidence concerning the Order must be submitted by 5:00 pm on 21 September 2026. The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

Oral comments concerning the Order must be presented at the scheduled public meeting. Interested parties are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide their comments. Certain designated parties may provide longer comments and have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence against him or her. The party subject to the proposed Order is designated parties. Any other party may request recognition as a designated party by submitting a written statement of how they are directly affected by the discharge(s) to be regulated and why they would like to be considered a designated party. Such requests must be submitted to Central Valley Water no later than 5:00 p.m. on 21 September 2025. Instructions on how to provide oral comments will be included in the Final Agenda for the meeting.

Proposed Order

Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. 5-00-093 was adopted in April 2000 and issued to the City of Arvin and United States Filter Corporation ARO Pistachios, Inc. WDRs Order 5-00-093 authorizes the discharge of up to 2.3 million gallons of domestic wastewater per day from the Arvin Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility) to storage reservoirs at 2401 El Camino Real in Arvin. Wastewater from the reservoirs is then

recycled to designated reclamation areas owned by the City of Arvin and, at the time of WDRs adoption, Community Recycling and Resource Recovery, Inc. (CRRR). In February 2022, the Central Valley Water Board adopted Order No. R5-2022-0017 recognizing the City of Arvin as the owner of the Facility, and Veolia Water West Operating Services, Inc. as the new operator.

If adopted, the proposed Order will recognize another change in ownership with regard to the designated reclamation areas. The portion of the designated reclamation areas previously held by CRRR are now owned by Shooshtar LP and operated by Zam Farming, LLC. Accordingly, the proposed Order would designate both the City of Arvin and Shooshtar LP, collectively, as the Discharger responsible for maintaining compliance with the requirements of existing WDRs 5-00-093.

To conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the proposed Order was sent only to the Discharger(s).
