**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will consider adoption of the subject rescission Order at a public meeting scheduled for:

The Final Agenda will provide the location and format of the meeting, the anticipated date that the proposed order will be considered, and the anticipated order of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed order. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed order.

### **Opportunities to Comment**

The Central Valley Water Board will consider oral and written comments on the proposed Order before it votes on whether to rescind the Order.

The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

**Oral comments** concerning the Order must be presented at the scheduled public meeting. Interested parties are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide their comments. Certain **designated parties** may provide longer comments and have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence against him or her. The parties subject to the proposed Order are designated parties. Any other party may request recognition as a designated party by submitting a written statement of how they are directly affected by the discharge(s) to be regulated and why they would like to be considered a designated party. Such requests must be submitted to Central Valley Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on 11 September 2025. Instructions on how to provide oral comments will be included in the Final Agenda for the meeting.

### **Proposed Order**

If adopted, the proposed Order will rescind WDRs Order 88-097, which prescribes requirements for the discharge of treated domestic wastewater to land at the Tulare County Resource Management Agency (Discharger) Delft Colony Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) located at 39360 Road 56 in Tulare County. WDRs Order 88-097 was adopted in June 1988 and authorizes wastewater discharge up to

57,200 gallons per day gpd to evaporation/percolation ponds. On 18 October 2023, Central Valley Waterboard staff requested an updated Report of Waste Discharge (RWD) to facilitate evaluation of the WWTF and determine whether the discharge qualifies for coverage under State Water Resources Control Board Order 2014-0153-DWQ, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems* (General Order). On 12 June 2025, Notice of Applicability 2014-0153-DWQ-R5427 was issued to the Discharger and will enroll the WWTF under the General Order upon rescission of WDRs Order 88-097.

To conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the proposed Order was sent only to the Discharger(s).
