NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING concerning

RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR

CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION DEUEL VOCATIONAL INSTITUTION CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENTS SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

In accordance with California Code of Regulations title 27 (Title 27), the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order R5-2017-0071 (9 June 2017) for the operation of four Class II surface impoundments used to contain the discharge of hypersaline wastewater (i.e., brine) generated in the production of potable drinking water at Deuel Vocational Institution (Facility) located at 23500 Kasson Road, Tracy.

The Facility is owned and operated by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (Discharger). On 25 September 2020, the Discharger announced closure of the Facility, which involved clean closure of its Class II surface impoundments in accordance with Title 27 section 21400.

Following clean closure activities, the Discharger submitted a Clean Closure Report dated 16 April 2021. Central Valley Water Board staff reviewed the Clean Closure Report and concurred, in a letter dated 21 June 2021, that any remaining areas of elevated concentration of waste with respect to calculated background threshold values are likely related to groundwater conditions at the site and not due to waste disposal activities associated with the operation of the Class II surface impoundments.

Therefore, since clean closure of the surface impoundments has been completed and they are no longer subject to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB)-promulgated requirements of Title 27, it is appropriate to rescind WDRs Order R5-2017-0071, permanently record clean closure activities in the SWRCB Geotracker database, and terminate any financial assurances requirements associated with the Class II surface impoundments.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **22 July 2024**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The Tentative WDRs were issued for a 30-day public comment period on **21 June 2024** and comments are due by **5:00 p.m.** on **22 July 2024**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m.** on **22 July 2024** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any person requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
