A tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order (Order) is proposed for the California Department of Transportation (Permittee), 06-0W920 Grapevine Rehabilitation Project (Project) in Kern County. The Project consists of the maintenance and rehabilitation of pavement and culverts on the Grapevine portion of Interstate 5 (I-5). Work in waters of the state is anticipated from Project activities including culvert replacements, clearing and grubbing, culvert installation and placement of new flared sections, and rock slop protection. Project impacts to aquatic resources include temporary impacts to 0.052 acre and 848 linear feet of stream channel as well as permanent impacts to 0.016 acre, 30.4 cubic yards, and 81.5 linear feet of stream channel. All impacted waters have been deemed by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to be outside of federal jurisdiction.

The tentative Order provides details of the proposed Project activities, including compensatory mitigation measures planned to compensate for the permanent loss of waters of the state and requiring avoidance and minimization measures to reduce on-site impacts during construction activities. The tentative Order describes technical conditions required to be met throughout the implementation of construction activities that allow for activities to meet Basin Plan objectives and other regulatory requirements.

Excluded material will not be considered by the Board.
