The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed order.

Opportunities to Comment

The Central Valley Water Board will consider oral and written comments on the proposed Order before it votes on whether to rescind the Order.

Written comments or evidence concerning the Order must be submitted by 5:00 pm on 20 March 2026. The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

Oral comments concerning the Order must be presented at the scheduled public meeting. Interested parties are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide their comments. Certain designated parties may provide longer comments and have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence against him or her. The parties subject to the proposed Order are designated parties. Any other party may request recognition as a designated party by submitting a written statement of how they are directly affected by the discharge(s) to be regulated and why they would like to be considered a designated party. Such requests must be submitted to Central Valley Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on 20 March 2026. Instructions on how to provide oral comments will be included in the Final Agenda for the meeting.

Proposed Order

If adopted, Rescission Order R5-2026-XXXX will rescind Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order R5-2014-0094 and Time Schedule Order (TSO) R5-2014-0095 for the Franzia Sanger Winery (Facility). The Franzia Sanger Winery (Facility) is located at 2916 South Reed Avenue in Sanger, and is owned by Cella Mountain, LLC (Discharger). The WDRs Order and TSO prescribe discharge and compliance schedule requirements for the Facility, respectively, and were both adopted on 8 August 2014. The WDRs Order authorizes the discharge of winery process wastewater up to 0.459 million gallons per day, or 70 million gallons per year, to a land application area (LAA), and the TSO includes a schedule to comply with the WDRs Order. Central Valley Water Board staff (Staff) received a 17 July 2025 letter from the Discharger stating that the Facility officially ceased operating on 30 June 2025. A 31 July 2026 Staff inspection letter indicates that closure activities, including monitoring well destruction, sump cleanout, and discharge line disconnection were completed. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind WDRs Order R5-2014-0094 and TSO R5-2014-0095.
