NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**GONZAGA RIDGE WIND FARM, LLC
GONZAGA RIDGE WIND FARM REPOWERING PROJECT
MERCED COUNTY**

A tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order (Order) is proposed for the Gonzaga Ridge Wind Farm, LLC (Permittee), Gonzaga Ridge Wind Farm Repowering Project (Project) in Merced County. The Project consists of replacing existing older model turbines and upgrade an existing wind energy facility with substantially fewer and more efficient wind turbines and associated facilities within Pacheco State Park. It is the second phase for the Gonzaga Ridge Site. Temporary fill, grading, excavation, and/or ground-disturbance impacts to waters of the state would occur because of new or improved construction access for new infrastructure, decommissioning, underground collection (fiber optic cabling) installation, site preparation, and installation of best management practices (BMPs). BMPs may include straw wattles, silt fences, habitat avoidance fencing, and grading/earthwork. All impacted waters have been deemed by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to be outside of federal jurisdiction.

The tentative Order provides details of the proposed Project activities, including requiring avoidance and minimization measures to reduce on-site impacts during construction activities. The tentative Order describes technical conditions required to be met throughout the implementation of construction activities that allow for activities to meet Basin Plan objectives.

The agenda will provide the anticipated date the hearing will be held for this item and anticipated order of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed order. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the tentative Order.

Nature and Purpose of Hearing

At the hearing, the Central Valley Water Board will hear testimony and oral comments regarding the tentative Order. This proceeding will be a formal adjudicatory proceeding. The [procedures governing Central Valley Water Board adjudicatory hearings](#) (http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/laws_regulations/) may be found at California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648 et seq. and are available upon request.

Prehearing Submission of Written Comments and Evidence

The **Permittee** is a party to this proceeding and may present evidence, including oral testimony. As a party, the Permittee must submit written evidence or comments, if any, for the Board to consider no later than **5:00 p.m. on 13 January 2025** via email to Brandon.Salazar@waterboards.ca.gov.

Interested persons include any non-party that is interested in the outcome of the hearing. Interested persons wishing to comment in writing on the tentative Order shall submit comments no later than **5:00 p.m. on 13 January 2025** via email to Brandon.Salazar@waterboards.ca.gov.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648.4, the Board Chair may refuse to admit written evidence or comments that are not submitted in accordance with this Notice and shall refuse to do so when there is a showing of prejudice to the Permittee or the Board. Excluded material will not be considered by the Board.

Visual Presentations

Hearing participants may use PowerPoint or other visual presentations at the hearing, but the presentation content shall not exceed the scope of previously submitted written material. Hearing Procedure and Time Limits

The hearing on the tentative Order will be conducted in the general order listed under California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648.5, except that the Board Chair may modify the order for good cause.

The **Permittee** and any other designated Party will be advised in advance of the hearing of the total amount of time allocated for their presentation, including any witness examination, and closing statement. The Permittee and any other designated Party are invited to contact staff in advance of the hearing to discuss how much time they believe is necessary.

Interested persons may speak at the hearing and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals, if any. Each interested person will have three minutes to present oral comments. Additional time may be provided, upon request, at the discretion of the Board Chair.
