#### **TUOLUMNE COUNTY**

Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) are tentatively being issued to the Jamestown Trust II, County of Tuolumne, Whiskey Lake LP, Jamestown Property Development LLC, David and Susan Kaslin, John and Amy Curtin, Mike and Amber Doescher, Joshua and Misty Wilson (Dischargers) for Jamestown Mine (Facility) located at 17855 High School Road, Jamestown, California 95327 in Tuolumne County.

The Facility is situated on a 733-acre property comprised of Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) shown in Table 1 of the enclosed tentative order. County of Tuolumne owns 326 acres which include the south part of Tailings Management Facility (TMF) and the TMF infrastructure including Process Water Retention Pond (PWRP), Rock Storage Area, and the DP-5 pond area east of the Harvard Pit. David and Susan Kaslin, the successors to Robert Cameron, own 272 acres which include the north half of TMF, the Crystal Pit, and the area between TMF and the Rock Storage Area (RSA). Whiskey Lake LP, a successor to Gary Wilson, owns 85 acres which include the Harvard Pit. Jamestown Property Development LLC, John and Amy Curtin, Mike and Amy Doescher, Joshua and Misty Wilson, are successors to Gary Wilson and own properties along Harvard Pit.

The revision of the current WDRs Order R5-2007-0083 is necessary because the current conditions at the Facility are significantly different from the time the Order was issued. The tentative order regulates closure and post-closure operations and maintenance of the Facility.

All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are **interested persons** and not designated parties. Interested persons may submit evidence (e.g., photographs, eyewitness testimony, monitoring data) if the evidence is submitted in accordance with the deadlines for submitting evidence described below. Interested persons who present evidence may be subject to cross-examination.

Interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **21 February 2025**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The Tentative WDRs were issued for a 30-day public comment period on 22 January 2025 and comments are due by 5:00 p.m. on 21 February 2025. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 p.m. on 21 February 2025 will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any person requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.
