a. MENDOZA RANCH (FORMER COZZI RANCH SWINE FACILITY), MERCED COUNTY, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 93-073

Individual Waste Discharge Requirements 93-073, adopted on 25 June 1993, prescribes requirements for operation of the Former Cozzi Ranch Swine Facility in Merced County. The facility no longer operates as a swine facility. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind Order 93-073.
