TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and tentative Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) for Midway Peaking LLC and PAO Investments LLC, Midway Peaking Facility. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative WDRs at its 12/13 December 2024 meeting in Rancho Cordova, California. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs must be submitted to this office by **5:00 pm on 4**November 2024. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
