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ORDER AMENDING WATER QUALITY ORDER NO. R5-2022-0014, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS; PORT OF STOCKTON, DENMAR NATURAL SODA ASH EXPORT TERMINAL PROJECT (WDID#5B39CR00357A1), SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

This Order responds to the 28 May 2026 request for an amendment of Water Quality Order No. R5-2022-0014 for the Denmar Natural Soda Ash Export Terminal Project (Project) (WDID#5B39CR00357). The original Water Quality Order (Order) was issued on 17 February 2022. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region hereby approves the requested amendment and amends the original order as described below. FINDINGS

The Port of Stockton is requesting a 5-year time extension through 16 February 2032 to complete the work.

The Order is amended to expire on 16 February 2032.

Application Fee Received

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$169,099.00 for the original Order were received on 9 October 2020 and 1 July 2021. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3383(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), and was calculated as category A - Fill & Excavation Discharges (fee code 84) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
