TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR RATTO BROTHERS, INC., STANISLAUS COUNTY

Enclosed are the Notice of Public Hearing, Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs), and Tentative Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) for Ratto Brothers, Inc. (Discharger) in Stanislaus County. A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) at its 11/12 December 2024 meeting, as explained in the enclosed Notice of Public Hearing.

To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the Tentative WDRs should be submitted to this office via email to centralvalleysacramento@waterboards.ca.gov with a carbon copy (cc) to jesse.milliken-callan@waterboards.ca.gov, no later than **5:00 p.m. on 10 November 2024**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.

To conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the Tentative WDRs has been sent only to the Discharger. Others are advised that the Tentative WDRs and additional information will be available electronically, within the next few days, on the Central Valley Water Boards Tentative Orders Webpage (http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/centralvalley/board decisions/tentative orders/).
