## TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR REDDING REGIONAL SEPTAGE DISPOSAL FACILITY, SHASTA COUNTY

## TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has prepared tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Redding Regional Septage Disposal Facility (Facility), which is owned and operated by Shasta County Department of Public Works (Discharger). The Central Valley Water Board is currently soliciting public comments on the tentative WDRs in accordance with the Notice of Public Hearing to adopt Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements, which is attached to this letter.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Orders at its **21/22 August 2025** Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. By **20 May 2025** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **27 May 2025.** 

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the discharger only. Interested persons are advised that the full text of the tentative documents is available on the <u>Central Valley Water Board's Tentative Orders web site</u> (www.waterboards.ca.gov/centralvalley/board\_decisions/tentative\_orders/).
