## **Proposed Changes Information**

On 4 March 2025, the U.S. Supreme Court issued a decision holding that the Clean Water Act does not authorize the inclusion of "end result" provisions (such as receiving water limitations) in NPDES Permits (City and County of San Francisco vs. U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (2025) 145 U.S. 704). This ruling impacts a number of pending NPDES permitting actions within the Central Valley Region. To comply with the U.S. Supreme Court decision, Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) staff have made proposed revisions to the following six tentative NPDES permits scheduled for the 19/20 June 2025 Board Meeting:

Central Valley Water Board staff developed a 2025 technical memorandum, <u>A Review of Receiving Water Limitations in Six National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Tentative Permits</u>, which provides a detailed analysis of the six NPDES tentative permits listed above to consider whether additional permit conditions need to be included with the removal of their receiving water limitations to meet federal and state regulations for protecting beneficial uses. Central Valley Water Board staff also developed a revisions document outlining the specific proposed changes to each of the tentative permits listed above that Board staff have deemed necessary to comply with the U.S. Supreme Court ruling.

### Nature and Purpose of Hearing

At the hearing, the Central Valley Water Board will hear testimony and oral comments regarding the proposed Orders, including the proposed receiving water limitation changes to these Orders. This proceeding will be a formal adjudicatory proceeding. The procedures governing Central Valley Water Board adjudicatory hearings (http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/laws\_regulations/) may be found at California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648 et seq. and are available upon request.

### **Prehearing Submission of Written Comments and Evidence**

Interested a parties must submit written evidence or comments, if any, for the Board to consider no later than 5:00 p.m. on **5 June 2025** to the Central Valley Water Board email at RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov.

**Interested persons** include any non-party that is interested in the outcome of the hearing. Interested persons wishing to comment, in writing, on the proposed receiving water limitation changes for NPDES permits shall submit comments no later than 5:00 p.m. on **5 June 2025** to the Central Valley Water Board email at <a href="mailto:RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov">RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov</a>.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648.4, the Board Chair may refuse to admit written evidence or comments that are not submitted in accordance with this Notice and shall refuse to do so when there is a showing of prejudice to the Discharger or the Board. Excluded material will not be considered by the Board.

#### **Visual Presentations**

Hearing participants may use PowerPoint or other visual presentations at the hearing, but the presentation content shall not exceed the scope of previously submitted written material. Presentations, if any, must be provided to the below Central Valley Water Board Contact by 12:00 p.m. on **17 June 2025**.

## **Hearing Procedure and Time Limits**

The hearing on the proposed Orders will be conducted in the general order listed under California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648.5, except that the Board Chair may modify the order for good cause.

The **Parties** will be advised in advance of the hearing of the total amount of time allocated for their presentation and closing statement. The Parties are invited to contact staff in advance of the hearing to discuss how much time they believe is necessary.

**Interested persons** may speak at the hearing and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals, if any. Each interested person will have 3 minutes to present oral comments. Additional time may be provided, upon request, at the discretion of the Board Chair.
