Enclosed for your review is a copy of the tentative revised waste discharge requirements (WDRs) and Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) for 28TH Street Landfill in Sacramento County. Also enclosed is a notice of public hearing (NOPH) to interested parties, pursuant to §21730 of Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 20005 et seq. (Title 27). The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs.

Written materials received after 5 p.m. on 27 December 2024 will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.
