TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER R5-2020-0038, SETTON PISTACHIO OF TERRA BELLA, INC., TERRA BELLA PISTACHIO FACILITY, TULARE COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative order rescinding Cease and Desist Order R5-2020-0038 for the Setton Pistachio of Terra Bella Inc. (Setton), Terra Bella Pistachio Facility (Facility) in Tulare County. The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will be considering the adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 24/25 April 2025 meeting. Any comments or recommendations you or others may have concerning the tentative Rescission Order must be submitted in writing to this office by 5:00 p.m. on 21 March 2025. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
