### **NOTICE OF TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SAN FRANCISCO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, 2023 STORMS – SITE M5A REPAIRS PROJECT, TUOLUMNE COUNTY**

#### **TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:**

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements for the 2023 Storms – Site M5a Repairs Project (Project) in Tuolumne County.

The 2.39-acre Project includes repairs and slope stabilization at three locations (Locations 1, 2, 3) where the 2023 storm events caused landslides/erosion. No water resources impacts are expected at Locations 1 and 2. Location 3, which includes an ephemeral drainage as well as roadside ditches, requires repairs to landslides on both the downslope and upslope portions of the roadway by removing unsuitable material and placement of rock slope protection. Additionally, the roadside drainage ditch at Location 3 will be restored to proper function by placing riprap at the inlet of an existing culvert and removal of a semicircular “chute” at the culvert outlet.
