TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SIERRA NEVADA CHEESE PLANT, GLENN COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has prepared tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Sierra Nevada Cheese Company's Cheese Processing Facility (Facility), which is owned and operated by Sierra Nevada Cheese Company, Inc., and Gregersen Properties, LLC (Discharger). The Central Valley Water Board is currently soliciting public comments on the tentative WDRs in accordance with the Notice of Public Hearing to adopt Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements, which is attached to this letter.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Orders at its **27/28 April 2023** Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. **By 13 March 2023** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **20 March 2023**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the discharger only.
