CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD CENTRAL VALLEY REGION ORDER R5-2025-xxxx RESCINDING VARIOUS WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board), finds that the Board adopted the following Order, which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

a. CALAVERAS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, TOYON MIDDLE SCHOOL WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, CALAVERAS COUNTY, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 97-074

Waste Discharge Requirements Order 97-074, adopted on 25 April 1997, prescribes requirements for the Toyon Middle School Wastewater Treatment Facility in Calaveras County. On 19 May 2022, the Calaveras Unified School District submitted a Report of Waste Discharge to obtain coverage under the Statewide General Order 2014-0153-DWQ for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems. Regulation of the discharge was transferred to enrollment under General Order WQ 2014-0153-DWQ-R5397, which was issued by the Executive Officer on 12 June 2025. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind Order 97-074.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Orders are rescinded on the date of this order unless otherwise stated above.
