NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING

TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT OF ALAMEDA COUNTY, INC. ALTAMONT SOLIDIFICATION FACILITY ALAMEDA COUNTY

Enclosed for your review is a copy of the tentative waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the proposed Altamont Solidification Facility in Alameda County. Also enclosed is a notice of public hearing (NOPH) to interested parties, pursuant to §21730 of Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 20005 et seq. (Title 27).
