RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for wastewater disposal facilities that were never constructed or are no longer in use.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
