RESCISSION OF

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for wastewater disposal facilities that are no longer in use, or are change of name and/or ownership Orders pertaining to facilities for which requirements have been either rescinded or updated.
