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EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

California Regional Water Quality Control Board Colorado River Basin



January 2023

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The Executive Officer (EO) of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Regional Water Board) hereby provides the following report on recent staff activities for November 2022 in the region:

1. LAND DISPOSAL - WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS PROGRAM

Approvals and Notifications: Six Approval/Notifications were issued to Dischargers:

- California Department of Water Resources was issued a Notice of Applicability for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality, Board Order 2003-0003-DWQ on November 1, 2022. The Discharger intends to discharge water to land from well development associated with groundwater monitoring well installation associated with the Vegetation Enhancement and Dust Suppression Projects at the Salton Sea. The Notice of Intent to enroll into the General Order was submitted on August 19, 2022. Imperial County [Adrianna Godinez]
- DCR Transmission, LLC. was issued a Notice of Applicability for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality, Board Order 2003-0003-DWQ on November 7, 2022. The Discharger intends to discharge water to land from construction dewatering associated with the installation of the Ten West Link 500 kilovolt Transmission Line Project. The Discharger's Notice of Intent was submitted on July 20, 2022. San Bernardino County [Adrianna Godinez]
- Truck Rock 29 HOA, subject to Board Order R7-2006-0036 was issued a letter on November 21, 2022, approving a timeline for their Wastewater Treatment Plant modifications. The modifications were required after a Notice of Violation was issued in November 2022 because several of the Facility 's components were discovered to be inoperable and other criteria required by the Facility's Board Orders were not being met. The Discharger is required to submit quarterly progress reports for one calendar year, starting in 2023, to monitor the Discharger's progress. San Bernardino County [Wendy Wyels]

2. UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK AND SITE CLEANUP PROGRAM

Regional Water Board staff continues to work with staff from the Department of Defense (DoD) to expedite ongoing activities at cleanup sites located at military facilities within the Colorado River Basin Region. The UST and SCP staff issued correspondence reviewing technical reports, requesting site access, providing direction for site assessment, and approving remedial action plans for sites currently in the assessment and cleanup process.
