## **Project Description:**

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) proposes to reconstruct up to 600 linear feet of the northern Ramer Lake levee where slumping and erosion has threatened the levee's stability. The levee embankment will be graded down to lake level and rebuilt using existing materials. Relocation and rehabilitation of approximately 1,200 linear feet of the existing Narcissus Drain would occur as part of the proposed

Project. CDFW will also replace a damaged 24-inch reinforced concrete pipe culvert and provide erosion and slope protection at the culvert outlet.

The Project will result in 0.161 acres (783 linear feet) of temporary impacts and 0.42 acres (1,077 linear feet) of permanent impacts to waters of the state.
