The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) invites you to participate in a formal public meeting to learn about the process to combine Athal Mutual Water Company and Fuller Acres Mutual Water Company with Lamont Public Utility District through consolidation, and the designation of Athal Mutual Water Company as a public water system in need of an administrator.

Fuller Acres Mutual Water Company and Athal Mutual Water Company have been out of compliance with California drinking water standards for 1,2,3-trichloropropane since May 2018. At this workshop, you will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback on a variety of topics.

This meeting is part of the Safe and Affordable Funding for Equity and Resilience (SAFER) program. The SAFER program was designed to ensure Californians who lack safe and affordable drinking water receive it as quickly as possible. The SAFER program is helping water systems achieve this goal through a set of tools, funding sources, and regulatory authorities.
