### NOTICE OF PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF CHANGES TO THE PROPOSED REGULATION TEXT

#### TITLE 22. Social Security DIVISION 4. Environmental Health CHAPTER 3.5. Onsite Treatment and Reuse of Nonpotable Water

#### SUBJECT: ONSITE TREATMENT AND REUSE OF NONPOTABLE WATER (SBDDW-22-001)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) has changed the text of the proposed regulations regarding onsite treatment and reuse of nonpotable water and is making the changed text available for public comment prior to adoption, amendment, or repeal of the resulting regulations.

A copy of the proposed regulation text with all changes to the original text is provided with this notice. A written description of the methods for illustrating such changes are provided as the first page of the changed text. Additionally, two new documents are being added to the rulemaking record.

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Due to the limitations of the email system, emails larger than 15 megabytes (MB) may be rejected and will not be delivered and received by the State Board. Therefore, emails larger than 15 MB should be submitted under separate emails or another form of delivery should be used.

The State Board requests but does not require that if reports or articles in excess of 25 pages are submitted in conjunction with the comments, the commenter provides a summary of the report or article and describes the reason for which the report or article is being submitted or is relevant to the proposed regulation.
