

WHAT THIS MEANS TO YOU

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) invites you to participate in a formal public meeting to learn about the process to connect Cutler Public Utility District's (PUD) drinking water system to Orosi Public Utility District (PUD) through consolidation, the joining of two or more water systems.

In August 2022, the State Water Board issued a compliance order to Cutler PUD for the violation of the 1,2,3-trichloropropane (1,2,3-TCP) maximum contaminant level. The first step in the process is to provide a six-month period for Cutler PUD and Orosi PUD to negotiate consolidation voluntarily. At this public meeting, customers and residents will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback on a variety of topics.

This meeting is part of the Safe and Affordable Funding for Equity and Resilience (SAFER) program. The SAFER program was designed to ensure Californians who lack safe and affordable drinking water receive it as quickly as possible. The SAFER program is helping water systems achieve this goal through a set of tools, funding sources, and regulatory authorities.
