### **Background**

On February 2020, the State Water Resources Control Board initiated the consolidation process for the West Water Company water system. The consolidation process requires two public meetings. The first public meeting was held on October 15, 2020, and this is the second public meeting continuing the mandatory consolidation process. The purpose of this meeting is to inform affected residents and interested parties about the process for consolidation of West Water Company with Sonoma County CSA-41. The consolidation is intended to provide a safe, reliable, and sustainable drinking water supply over the long term through necessary water system improvements. The State Water Resources Control Board is seeking input from West Water Company customers and other interested parties concerning this process.

The West Water Company water system's well source is only 62 feet deep, does not have the proper seal, the casing is in poor physical condition, and it is nearing the end of its useful life. The water system was placed on a precautionary boil water notice in February 2019 as a result of E. coli bacteria being found in the untreated water produced by the well. Based on water production records, West Water Company does not have storage capacity equal to its maximum day demand as required by Section 64554 of the California Code of Regulations.
