SAMPLE REPORT FIELD HEADINGS

County City Name	Licensed Child Care Center details.
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LabNumber	Identification number of accredited lab that tested the drinking water.
Id	Nine-digit number assigned to licensed child care center.
SampleSiteId	Identification assigned to faucet or drinking fountain for sampling. Letters with 30 (for example, A30) indicate a 30-second flush before sampling.
RegOffice	Regional Office identification number, Child Care Licensing Program.
XMOD	Modifier of <, "less than", used when results are less than 1 microgram per liter.
Result	Lead testing results shown in micrograms per liter (ug/l), which is the same as parts per billion. Results of 15 ug/l or higher require action by the child care facility to replace the faucet and/or provide bottled drinking water.
SampleDate	Date that water sample was taken.
AnalysisDate	Date that water sample was analyzed by lab.
LoadDate	Date that lab uploaded the water sampling data to the Water Boards database.
UnitofMeasure	UG/L is the abbreviation for micrograms per liter, the unit of measure used to record the presence of lead in drinking water. For water, 1 ug/l = 1 ppb, or one part per billion.
