Subject: Amend and Re-Submit 2024 Groundwater Local Cooperative Solution – Murphy Ranch

Hi Scott,

As we discussed by phone yesterday, on July 16, 2024, I am following up with you to confirm the plan to amend your LCS proposal, and to resubmit it for reconsideration.

Proposed amendments:

- 1. **Reduce the total acreage from 61 to 38 acres** because you intend to fallow 23 acres (Field 1) that will be covered under a grant with CDFW and not included in your LCS.
- 2. Change the LCS type(s) from Best Management Practices/Graduated Cessation Schedule to a Percent Reduction that uses the same actions detailed in your 2022 proposal (attached) to reduce water usage by at least 30% compared to the 2020 baseline year.
- 3. Include the following actions as your methods for water use reduction:
 - a. **Field 2:** Irrigated by wheel lines in both 2020 and 2024, you have replaced the nozzles with smaller ones and plan to decrease your set times from approximately 11.5 hours to 8 hours.
 - b. **Field 3:** In 2020, the 25 acres were irrigated by wheel line, but you have since replaced the wheel lines with a LESA pivot system.

In 2022, you rotated the grass out and planted grain, resulting in a water use reduction. Please provide specific details for the water use reduction in 2024 now that alfalfa has been planted (vs. grain).

- 4. **Include a plan to install a flow meter on your pivot** that irrigates 25 acres (Field 3) of the total 38 acres. The meter will be installed in Winter 2024-25, and you agree to record data for one full irrigation season from the time of installation and report the data to the State Water Board.
- 5. **Include a plan to monitor water usage** for your wheel lines and pivot by recording set times and duration, that will be reported monthly to the Coordinating Entity or the State Water Board, whichever is applicable.

Review and revise the attached 2024 Spreadsheet:

In the attached 2024 spreadsheet, I have removed the 23 acres (Field 1) that you intend to exclude from the proposal. Can you please review the 2024 spreadsheet and make any

necessary revisions (e.g., water application amounts for 2024, irrigation type, hours per set, etc.)? It looks like Wheat Hay was being irrigated for Field 3 (25 acres) back in 2022, and you advised that alfalfa has since been planted, so application amounts may need to be adjusted.

Action Items:

- 1. Confirm that my understanding of the changes to be made to the LCS proposal are accurate and/or provide clarifying information.
- 2. Provide specific details for the water use reduction in 2024 now that alfalfa has been planted (vs. grain).
- 3. Make any necessary revisions to the attached 2024 Spreadsheet (e.g., water application amounts for 2024, irrigation type, hours per set, etc.).

Once we receive the information requested and revisions to the 2024 spreadsheet, I will rescind the "denial" and we can move forward with processing your application. It would be great if we could have this information by COB on Friday, July 19, 2024, but I understand the current evacuation order could prevent you from meeting this request.
