This is a Public Notice by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region (Lahontan Water Board) that the Lahontan Water Board will hold a public hearing to receive public comments and consider adoption of the revised Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Waste Discharges Resulting from Timber Harvest and Vegetation Management Activities in the Lahontan Region, Board Order No. R6T-2024-[PROP] (2024 Timber Waiver).

If adopted, the 2024 Timber Waiver will regulate waste discharges resulting from timber harvest and vegetation management activities throughout the Lahontan Region.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Lahontan Water Board will hold a public hearing to receive public comments and consider adoption of the 2024 Timber Waiver.

This notice sets forth the procedures and processes the Lahontan Water Board will use at this proceeding and contains important deadlines. The Lahontan Water Board will hold a public hearing and consider adoption of the 2024 Timber Waiver, as follows:

**Video and Teleconference Option:** This meeting will occur with both the physical meeting locations described above and an option for the public to participate from a remote location.

This public meeting is currently scheduled to take place in-person and via video and teleconference, but the format may be changed in the future. Any person wishing to obtain information about changes to the date, time, location, or format of the meeting should visit the Board's website:

The final meeting agenda will be available on the Board's website at least 10 days before the meeting. The agenda will provide the location and format of the meeting, the anticipated date the hearing will be held for this item, and the anticipated order of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed order. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed order.

Advanced Zoom registration is required to participate telephonically or by computer.

Participants in this proceeding are identified as either "Parties" or "Interested Persons." Designation as a Party is not necessary to participate in this proceeding. Both Interested Persons and Parties will have the opportunity to present oral comments. Both Interested Persons and Parties may be asked to respond to clarifying questions from the Lahontan Water Board members, counsel, or staff, or others, at the discretion of the of the Board.

Parties to the hearing may present evidence. The Board meetings does not generally require the prior identification of witnesses, the cross examination of witnesses, or other procedures not specified in this notice. Parties or persons with special procedural requests should contact staff, who will endeavor to accommodate reasonable requests.

Interested Persons include any person or organization that is interested in the outcome of the hearing, but who has not been designated as a Party. Interested Persons may present oral comments at the hearing, but they may not present evidence. Oral comments include policy statements and/or arguments about the appropriateness, wisdom, or utility of the proposal before the Lahontan Water Board. Interested Persons are not subject to cross-examination and may not cross-examine witnesses.

All designated Parties and Interested Persons may speak at the Lahontan Water Board meeting. Oral comments should avoid repeating previous comments to allow all persons time to be heard. Interested Persons with similar concerns or opinions are encouraged to choose one representative to speak and are encouraged to coordinate their presentations with each other. Oral comments will be limited to five (5) minutes each. Any person may ask for additional time for their oral comment by sending a request with a justification supporting the request and the requested amount of time to the Board Clerk, Katrina Fleshman at <a href="Lahontan@waterboards.ca.gov">Lahontan@waterboards.ca.gov</a> or by contacting her directly at (530) 542-5414 by 5:00 p.m. by April 10, 2024. Please indicate in the subject line "2024 Timber Waiver."

Interested Persons requesting additional time will be advised prior to the date of the hearing of the amount of time they will be allocated. The decision to grant or deny additional time will be based upon the complexity and the number of issues under consideration, the extent to which entities and persons have coordinated, the number of interested persons anticipated, the extent to which entities and persons have identified unique interests, and the time available for the hearing. It is the Lahontan Water Board's intent that reasonable requests be accommodated.
