The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) staff transmitted a letter containing the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES permit, and responses to comments for the City of Ventura's Ventura Water Reclamation Facility Ocean Outfall on December 4, 2025.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Los Angeles Water Board at a public hearing held on December 18, 2025, reviewed the revised tentative requirements, considered all the factors in the case, and adopted WDRs and NPDES Order No. **R4-2025-0272**.
