ORDER NO. R4-2006-0077

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board), finds:

- The Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) contained in Order No. 92-086 for BKK Corporation (Discharger) on December 7, 1992, for the reuse of wastewater from the Cogeneration Plant at the BKK landfill facility in West Covina, California.
- 2. Starting from September 1999, the Discharger has been discharging all wastewater generated at the Cogeneration Plant to the Los Angeles County sanitary sewer system.
- 3. Board staff has verified, by inspection, that this facility has discontinued discharging.
- 4. The Board finds that these requirements are no longer applicable and should be rescinded.
- 5. The Board has transmitted copies of a tentative Order to the Discharger and to interested agencies and persons, and has notified them of its intent to rescind the requirements.
- 6. At a public meeting on October 24, 2006, the Board gave the opportunity for a hearing and considered comments and correspondence pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Waste Discharge Requirements, Order No. 92-086 be rescinded.

The Executive Officer of the Board, is authorized, and he is hereby directed, to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies as may have need therefor, or may request same.
