TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT— PARK WATER COMPANY—WELL NO. 19C, 1743 E. 118th STREET, COMPTON, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-9243)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.


We have reviewed your January 14, 2011, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed development and testing of Well No. 19C and that you have stopped the groundwater discharge to storm drain.

On April 21, 2011, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005, for the facility is hereby terminated.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.

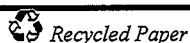
