TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—WILSHIRE PACIFIC PARTNER LLC-WILSHIRE PACIFIC PLAZA, 12301 WILSHIRE BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9256)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.


We have reviewed your January 28, 2011, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have obtained a wastewater discharge permit from City of Los Angeles to discharge groundwater to sanitary sewer system and that you have stopped the groundwater discharge to storm drain.

On April 14, 2011, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated.

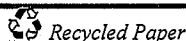
Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
