TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

- 1. This Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR), Order No R4-2005-0068 for The Boeing Company (Discharger) on October 6, 2005 for discharge of treated groundwater to groundwater basins in Los Angeles Region at the former Boeing Compton Facility located at 233 E. Manville Street and 157 E. Stanley Street, California.
- 2. On July 2, 2010, Discharger notified this Regional Board that the Discharger has ceased its discharge to groundwater basins.
- 3. The Regional Board finds that the WDR Order No. R4-2005-0068 is no longer applicable and shall be terminated.
- 4. The WDR Order No. R4-2005-0068 is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
- 5. The termination of WDR is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider termination of Order No. R4-2005-0068 and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations. The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the Order.

The Executive Officer of this Regional Board is authorized, and he is hereby directed, to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies that request it.
