SYSTEM NO. 1995003 – COMMENTS ON CITY OF BURBANK TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS

The Division of Drinking Water (Division) received a copy of the Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Water Reclamation Requirements (WWRs) on February 22, 2016 from the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) via electronic mail. The Division has reviewed the document and has the following comments:

- 1. **XII. USE AREA REQUIREMENTS. Item 15:** The Division does not certify backflow testers. Any mention of a Division certified backflow device tester should be removed.
- 2. MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM (MRP) CI-6753. I. GENERAL MONITORING REQUIREMENTS. Item 6: the Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program (ELAP) is no longer under the authority of California Health Services. ELAP was transferred to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) in conjunction with the Division's transfer to the SWRCB. ELAP is now a section under the Division.
