CHANGE SHEET FOR REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS (WWRs) - CITY OF BURBANK, BURBANK WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (FILE NO. 83-25, CI-6753)

On March 29, 2016, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff sent you revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Water Reclamation Requirements (WRRs) for the above-mentioned Water Reclamation Plant. Regional Water Board staff considered comments submitted and prepared a change sheet to eliminate duplicative monitoring requirements associated with radioactivity.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on April 14, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., at the City of Simi Valley, Council Chambers, 2929 Tapo Canyon Road, Simi Valley, California, will consider the enclosed Revised Tentative WDRs/WRRs and comments submitted in writing regarding the changes contained within the proposed amended Order. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.

The Regional Water Board proposes to remove a redundant monitoring requirement in Table M1 for radioactivity, and the corresponding footnote which accompanies it, because radionuclides are already included in the list of pollutants under Attachment A.

²⁵ Radionuclides to be monitored are: Combined Radium-226 and Radium-228, Gross Alpha particle activity (excluding radon and uranium), Uranium, Strontium-90, Tritium, and Gross Beta.
