**TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR COUNTY OF VENTURA PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY, TODD ROAD JAIL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, 600 SOUTH TODD ROAD, VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 91-076, CI NO. 7418)**

Dear Mr. Pakala:

On March 7, 2011, you filed a Report of Waste Discharge (ROWD) for disposal of treated wastewater from the Todd Road Jail Wastewater Treatment Plant. We have completed our review of your application for Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) for the County of Ventura Public Works Agency. Pursuant to the California Water Code, a tentative waste discharge requirements and revised monitoring and reporting program have been prepared.

Enclosed are copies of the Tentative WDR consisting of:

- a. Board Order No. R4-2011-XXXX,
- b. Tentative Standard Provisions Applicable to WDR, and
- c. Revised Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 7418.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board will consider the enclosed tentative WDRs and comments therein at a public hearing to be held at 9:00 AM on December 8, 2011 at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board at its discretion may order further investigation.

In order to be fully evaluated by the Regional Board staff and included in the Regional Board's agenda packet, written comments must be received at the Regional Board's office by 5:00 p.m. on November 18, 2011. Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for the Board to refuse to admit the proposed written comment or exhibit into evidence. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that Regional Board Members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.
