TENTATIVE ORDER – TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR VILLAGE CARWASH AT 3369 THOUSAND OAKS BOULEVARD, THOUSAND OAKS, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. 98-011, CI-7864, FILE NO. 97-013)

Dear Ms. Galley:

On January 29, 1998, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) adopted Water Discharge Requirements (WDR), Order No. 98-011 for Galley Enterprises for the discharge of treated groundwater to the subsurface via an on-site recharge trench at Village Carwash located at 3369 Thousand Oaks Boulevard, Thousand Oaks, California.

On June 17, 2011, Mr. Kent Tucker of FREY Environmental Inc., on behalf of Galley Enterprises, notified the Regional Board that the groundwater remediation system was turned off on June 15, 2011, and dismantled at the subject location, and the WDR is no longer needed.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Regional Board, at a public meeting, will consider the enclosed tentative Order, which, in part, will terminate WDR Order No. 98-011. The meeting will be held at 9:00 a.m. on October 6, 2011, at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California.

In order to be fully evaluated by Regional Board staff and included in the Board's agenda packet, written comments must be received at the Regional Board office by 5:00 p.m. on September 16, 2011. Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for the Board to refuse to admit the proposed written comment or exhibit into evidence. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide a timely review, and that Regional Board Members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.

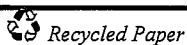

**TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER
(Village Carwash – Galley Enterprises)**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) finds:

1. On January 29, 1998, this Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) contained in Order No. 98-011 for Galley Enterprises (Discharger) for discharge of treated groundwater to the subsurface via an on-site recharge trench at Village Carwash located at 3369 Thousand Oaks Boulevard, Thousand Oaks, California (site).
2. On June 17, 2011, the Discharger requested that the Regional Board terminate Order No. 98-011 since the groundwater remediation system was turned off on June 15, 2011, and dismantled.
3. Because the groundwater remediation has been completed at the site, the Regional Board finds that Order No. 98-011, with waste discharge requirements, is no longer applicable and shall be terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
4. The termination of Order No. 98-011 is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with California Water Code (CWC) section 13389.
5. The Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider termination of Order No. 98-011, and has provided them with an opportunity to submit comments.
6. The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Order No. 98-011 is terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

The Executive Officer of this Regional Board is authorized, and is hereby directed, to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies that request it.
