WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – CALABASAS LANDFILL, AGOURA HILLS, CA (FILE NO. 60-118)

Dear Mr. Louie:

Section 13263 of the California Water Code provides for the periodic review and revision by the Regional Board of waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for landfill facilities. Because WDRs for the Calabasas Landfill (Regional Board Order No. 89-053, adopted May 22, 1989) no longer accurately reflect current conditions at the Calabasas Landfill, we intend to revise them.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Regional Board, at a public meeting to be held on April 2, 2009 beginning at 9:00 am., at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, CA, 90013, will consider adoption of the enclosed tentative requirements and written comments regarding any or all requirements thereof. It is expected that the Regional Board will take action at the meeting, however as testimony indicates, the Regional Board at its discretion may order further investigation.

In order to be fully evaluated by Regional Board staff and included in the Regional Board's agenda packet, written comments must be received at the Regional Board's office by 5:00 pm on March 10, 2009.
