TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – SUNSHINE CANYON CITY/COUNTY LANDFILL, SYLMAR, CALIFORNIA (File No. 58-76)

Dear Mr. Hauser:

Our letter dated June 18, 2008, informed you that the Joint Technical Document (JTD) you submitted to this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) to apply for revised waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the proposed Sunshine Canyon City/County Landfill (Landfill) was complete. In accordance with the California Water Code, we have prepared tentative revised waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the discharge of municipal solid waste at the Landfill. Enclosed are copies of the tentative requirements, consisting of:

- a. Waste Discharge Requirements
- b. Monitoring and Reporting Program (Attachment T)
- c. Definitions (Attachment A)
- d. Standard Provisions (Attachment W)

Written comments regarding the tentative Order must be received at the Regional Board office by the close of business on **September 8, 2008**, in order to be evaluated by Board staff and included in the Board's agenda folder. Submittal of written comments by the deadline is required to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able
