TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDR) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT - CITY OF OXNARD, OXNARD WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0054097, CI NO. 2022)

We have completed our review of your application for renewal of the permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES).

Oral statement will be heard, but, for the accuracy of the record, all testimony should be submitted in writing. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.

Written comments regarding the tentative waste discharge requirements or NPDES permit must be received at the Regional Board's office (address indicated below) by the close of business on April 01, 2008, in order to be evaluated by Board staff, and included in the Board's agenda folder. Comments received after that date will be provided, ex agenda, to the Board for their consideration. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record that Board staff are able to provide timely review, and that Regional Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.

With respect to the public notices, in accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and California Code of Regulations, you are required to follow the enclosed instructions for posting of the notice no later than March 07, 2008.

Failure to post the notice by the above date may require us to reschedule this item for a later hearing and will require posting of a second notice. Please notify this Board by telephone when the notice has been posted and submit the proof of posting as required in the enclosed instructions. Proof of posting the notice must be received by the Executive Officer of this Regional Board no later than March 14, 2008.
