TENTATIVE AMENDMENT, COPPER WATER EFFECTS RATIO (WER) FOR WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT — CITY OF SAN BUENAVENTURA, VENTURA WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY (NPDES NO. CA0053651, CI NO. 1822)

Dear Mr. Pfeifer:

A copper WER of 1.58 was applied to the final limits for copper in Order No. R4-2008-0011, adopted by the Regional Board on March 6, 2008. The Regional Board also directed staff to meet with the City of San Buenaventura and re-evaluate the possibility of applying a higher copper WER value.

Following the March 6, 2008 Board Hearing, the City prepared a follow-up response in an effort to reach agreement with Regional Board staff and resolve the issue of which WER is the most appropriate to use in calculating the final copper effluent limits for the discharge. Additional data were provided to staff.

Regional Board staff re-evaluated all of the data with regard to critical conditions in the Estuary, and followed the USEPA guidance on using the geometric mean of the individual sample WERs to calculate the final WER. Based upon two sampling periods (five data points) that represent the most critical conditions in the Estuary, which is wintertime with the berm open, a revised WER of 2.08 is found to be protective and appropriate.

Accordingly, pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended; and in accordance with the California Water Code, a tentative amendment for the waste discharge requirements has been prepared for the Board's consideration.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on December 11, 2008, at 9:00 a.m., at Ventura County Government Center, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, California 90034, will consider the enclosed tentative amendment and comments submitted in writing regarding any and all portions thereof. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the tentative amendment. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.

Written comments regarding the tentative amendment must be received at the Regional Board office by the close of business on November 13, 2008, in order to be evaluated by Board staff and included in the Board's agenda folder. Comments received after that date will be provided, ex agenda, to the Board for their consideration. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that Regional Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised. Comments received after the requested date may result in delay in consideration of the tentative Order.

With respect to the public notices, in accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and California Code of Regulations, you are required to follow the enclosed instructions for posting of the notice no later than October 20, 2008.

Failure to post the notice by the above date may require us to reschedule this item for a later hearing and will require posting of a second notice. Please notify this Board by telephone when the notice has been posted and submit the proof of posting as required in the enclosed instructions. Proof of posting the notice must be received by the Executive Officer of this Regional Board no later than October 27, 2008.
