RESPONSE TO COMMENTS ON THE TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) – AES ALAMITOS, LLC; ALAMITOS GENERATING STATION; LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NUMBER CA0001139, CI NUMBER 6113)

On September 22, 2023, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) transmitted the tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) for the Alamitos Generating Station (Facility). The Los Angeles Water Board considered all comments submitted by October 23, 2023, and revised the tentative TSO where appropriate. Enclosed are our response to comments and the revised tentative TSO.

The Los Angeles Water Board will consider the revised tentative TSO at a public hearing to be held on **November 16, 2023, at 9:00 A.M**. The hearing will be held at the following address:

At the hearing, the Los Angeles Water Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the revised tentative TSO.
