The injection of remediation compounds into the subsurface at the above-referenced site is proposed to remediate residual organic contamination (tetrachloroethene [PCE], and its daughter products). This action has been proposed as an interim remedial corrective action to cleanup groundwater contaminated by releases made by historical facilities formerly located at the site. The injection of 3D-Microemulsion and Bio-Dechlor will create a reducing environment that will promote the destruction of residual organic contamination in soil and groundwater.

North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff intends to extend coverage under "General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2009-0105 for *In Situ* Soil and Groundwater Remediation for Volatile Organic Compound and/or Metal Impacted Sites within the North Coast Region" (General WDR) for this project. The General WDR was adopted by the Regional Water Board on December 10, 2009.

The Regional Water Board Executive Officer may authorize coverage for the proposed project under the General WDR without further public notice unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site by the end of the comment period.
