## **Notice of Proposed No Further Action**

A soil and groundwater investigation was conducted at the above-referenced site and a release of petroleum hydrocarbons was documented. Although some contamination remains, this site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's "Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy." Regional Water Board staff proposes that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

## **Problem Description**

An unauthorized release was discovered during the removal of five gasoline underground storage tanks (USTs) and one waste oil UST from this operating retail gas station in June 1990. Soil and groundwater remediation measures have been conducted from 2003 through 2018. The primary constituents of concern (COCs) related to the unauthorized release are comprised of Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg); benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX); and methyl tertbutyl ether (MTBE). Current site conditions have been evaluated compared to the State's Low Threat UST Closure Policy (Policy). The site conditions satisfy all general criteria of the Policy and residual COC concentrations in groundwater are decreasing and expected to achieve water quality objectives in a reasonable timeframe, and the remaining impacted groundwater does not present a significant risk to the environment or human health.
